Our Global Conversation Launch Event took place on 13 June 2023. The event was attended by over 100 stakeholders from 20 countries, representing organisations drawn from across the full extent of the R&D ecosystem, with a notable mix of global, regional, and country level representation. Phase 2 Exploring the Four Key Areas for Change: Identifying priorities, complex issues, and potential solutions.

Phase 2 consisted of four events that took place towards the end of June and beginning of July. The four events provided a space for a global cohort of stakeholders to come together to hold fruitful conversations regarding the four key areas for reform of the infectious disease R&D ecosystem. The outputs of these valuable discussions have been fed into the co-creation of the agendas of the Phase 3 deep dive events.
