### Request for Proposal (RFP) for Climate Finance Advisor

	Question	Answer
1.	Will Wellcome consider an institutional submission so to draw on the considerable expertise of a wider network?	We are open to applications from institutions/ organisations.
2.	Is Wellcome open to an advisor from Academia?	We are open to applications from Academia.
3.	Would you be open to more than one academic, for example a partnership of two covering health and climate finance?	We are open to more than one academic – and will consider applications from a partnership.
4.	What is the end objective of this piece of work/ does it include a defined output such as a report or setting up a unit? Or is it more of an advisory/ strategy focused opportunity?	We have not defined specific outputs for this contract. We are keen to work with the supplier(s) to identify entry points within the global dialogue and strategically build our policy narrative in this space. Indicative products could include position statements, talking points, and advisory briefings.
5.	How much desk-based research work and roughly how many outputs are envisioned for 'Undertake economic analysis to develop policy position that presents health arguments for increasing scale and access to climate finance by developing countries and/or promote healthier adaptation and mitigation projects'?	The work undertaken by the supplier will be predominantly desk-based research. We have not defined the number of outputs, and will work with the supplier(s) to determine what is necessary, and feasible depending on external factors and internal demand.
