This policy sets out our commitments and areas of focus to managing the environmental impacts of our operations. It applies to our employees, contractors, agency staff, service partners, and tenants.

Context

The science could not be clearer: humanity is facing a self-made climate and nature emergency of unprecedented scale, and urgent action is needed now to safeguard our common future.

This is a health crisis as much as an environmental one. As a global funder with climate and health as a key aspect of our mission, Wellcome has an important role to play addressing this crisis by driving impact through our mission and our leadership, and by reducing the impacts of our own operations.

Our commitments

How we operate is part of our impact in the world, and we are committed to tackle our own environmental impacts. We are at the beginning of a transformative journey to incorporate environmental sustainability considerations across everything we do and to achieve net-zero emissions.

- Comply with all relevant environmental laws, regulations, and other requirements.
